I am in receipt of your letter of April 12, 2013 responding to my request pursuant to California Government Code §6250-6268 for public records in your possession.

Enclosed is my check for \$9.20 for copies, one each, of the 13 pages you cite in your letter and an additional \$3 to cover postage to my above address.*

Several concerns are raised by your statement in your letter that:

"The district is not privy to Albion Little River Volunteer Fire Department, Inc. financial information and therefore cannot answer questions regarding the status and disposition of monies and other assets currently owned by said non-profit entity"

The current status of this "non-profit entity," according the California Secretary of State, is "suspended," a fact which I have reason to believe is known to you.

It is your obligation under the law to assist the public in the most broad way possible in identifying documents that are relevant to a request. It is specifically not required that the requester be specific regarding the exact documents sought. Your comment appears to narrow my request, which is for documents relating to current and past assets, in that it only addresses current assets. Furthermore, your reply cites a status of the Fire Department (as an incorporated non-profit) that no longer exists.

To assist you in understanding what is being requested I will rephrase the original request. If you find that the documents you have already cited fully and completely meet the rephrased request, no further action is needed. If you have additional material to add in light of this rephrasing, treat this as new request (but omit the documents you are already providing under the original request).

My request is for all documents in your possession that relate in any way to monies or other assets currently or formerly held by the Albion-Little River Volunteer Fire Department, Inc. or by persons representing themselves as such that are now in your possession. What is being sought is exactly what happened to donated and/or earned funds or other assets held by the corporation after the department

was in effect taken over by the district. The objective is to determine if state and federal regulations regarding the dissolution of a non-profit corporation and the dispersal of remaining assets were followed by both the corporation and by the district and to determine if persons asserting authority within the department and/or the district that resulted in such dispersals in fact had such authority at the time such dispersals were made.

I trust this is a clear enough request. Thank you for your continued cooperation in this matter.
