I want to see the hood rigmarole conclude as soon as possible and without drama.

Fact pattern:

- board asked that the hood not be purchased
- hood was purchased
- board asked that the hood not be installed
- hood was installed (but not to code?)

I find myself in a difficult position. I want the stove ready for the auxiliary and community to use in advance of the BBQ. I'm not authorized to approve a construction project. I'm prepared to ask for a special meeting to approve completion by a licensed and insured contractor.

If you want a different plan, I won't argue against you, but you need to seek district approval first, before any work is performed, no matter how well intentioned.

- > HI Ted and Chris,
- > The authorist direction
- > The exhaust ducting from the hood was installed per the manufacturer, but it doesn't look very nice. I have purchased rigid ducting and am planning to measure it, have Josh Latkin cut it and we will install it this week. Josh will also have a backplate made up that will direct the exhaust from the ovens directly into the hood. I plan to fix the hood to the ceiling using the trim that came with it using wooden supports attached to the rafters to prevent the hood from moving and tearing loose from the rigid ducting in a seismic event.
- > The District Board is in no way involved with either the work on the hood or the cost. I will pay for all materials used in this project. If the Auxiliary wishes to reimburse me, that is up to them, not the District.
- > Rich Riley and I, and maybe a few people from the Auxiliary, will continue to clean out the meeting room. I may be adding additional shelving for the books, etc. currently on the floor. I do need to know if you are going to take advantage of the offer to paint the building for only the cost of the paint. If you are, then we will wait for that to happen. Joe gave you the name of the painter which follows:
- > "We have an offer from a commercial painter (John Darcy and Wesley Walsh) to paint the inside of the building for free if we do the preparation and buy the material. He recommended 15 gallons of Zinsser mold killing primer. I think since the building is very nearly empty we should take him up on his offer. Fresh paint would go a long way getting the 50 years of stink off the place."
- > Please keep in mind this is the only Station you will have that has a restroom, a shower and a washing

machine for the next 2 to 5 years, if not longer.


