Fund Raising, Gifts, Service Fees:

o The Little River Concert Series performance on February 8 was to benefit Albion-Little River Volunteer Fire Department, Inc. Ted Williams attended and spoke with guests at the intermission. Proceeds have not been calculated by ALRVFD, Inc.

Development:

- o Focus remains on legal compliance, training the basics to new firefighters, personal protective equipment standardization and issue, cleaning and maintenance.
- o Ted continued to research CAFS and believe we should pursue a starter system.
- Ted met CHP at station 811 for a VIN verification of engine 8170 (USDA FS) and completed registration with the DMV. 8170 now has plates.

- On January 14, Marshall and Andrea restocked rescue 8130 with 2 BVM, 2 infant BVM, 2 manual suction, tourniquet, sterile supplies, Band-Aids, chest seals, abdominal pads, 3 rolls of sam splints, gloves, snap straps (replacing sticky straps), and head blocks (now only one type).
- o On January 14, Marshall, Erica and Andrea washed 8170 and 8162.
- o The flats has offered to store a container for our boat/water equipment. Close proximity and easy access will provide much shorter response times.
- Driver/Operator 1A written exam results are not yet available from Sacramento.
- We will investigate a district operated BLS ambulance as part of our long range plan.

Station Maintenance

- We held a work party on January 28. Stations 810 and 811 were cleaned. We disposed of over five cubic yards of trash and deprecated equipment. We plan to address station 812 next.
- Mendocino Coast Water Works completed plumbing replacement of old waste and gas lines. The gas pipes passed a test provided by our propane vendor.
- o Ted researched the history of West Street, the entrance road to station 810. The county Department of Transportation now agrees that the street is a county right of way, but was not able to locate a record of the street being maintained. Norman DeVall was able to recall county improvements to the road during his term as supervisor. Dan Hamburg, current 5th district supervisor, has offered to make the case for county maintenance in March when supervisors' vote on the "maintained mileage list". According to Hamburg, Howard Dashiell, director of MCDoT, will recommend adding West Street Albion-0.2 miles (100 feet) to the list. If successful, this will put the county road crew on track to rock in April or May. A concern raised which could negatively impact the project is continued use of the area by adjacent property owners as a private driveway and parking area.

 - d. Banking: The board discussed modification of current banking and fiscal procedures and took the following action:
 - i. The board voted to establish a district credit card account by unanimous approval of Resolution 120112.1.
 - ii. The board voted to establish electronic banking capabilities for all district bank accounts by unanimous approval of Resolution 120112.2.
 - iii. The board voted to establish additional checking and savings accounts to facilitate receipt of general donations to the district by unanimous approval of Resolution 120112.3.
 - iv. Resolution to establish the new maximum amount of the county/district revolving fund was not required and no action was taken on this item. Previous authorization letter to county auditor was sufficient for establishment of new fund limits.
 - **e. Apparatus liquidation:** At the recommendation of Chief Williams and the firefighters the Board voted unanimously on a motion by Ken to decommission the district's 1973 Van Pelt type I fire engine currently designated 8182 and keep it for repair parts for other similar district owned vehicles.

BOARD OF DIRECTORS SPECIAL ANNUAL EVALUATION SESSION

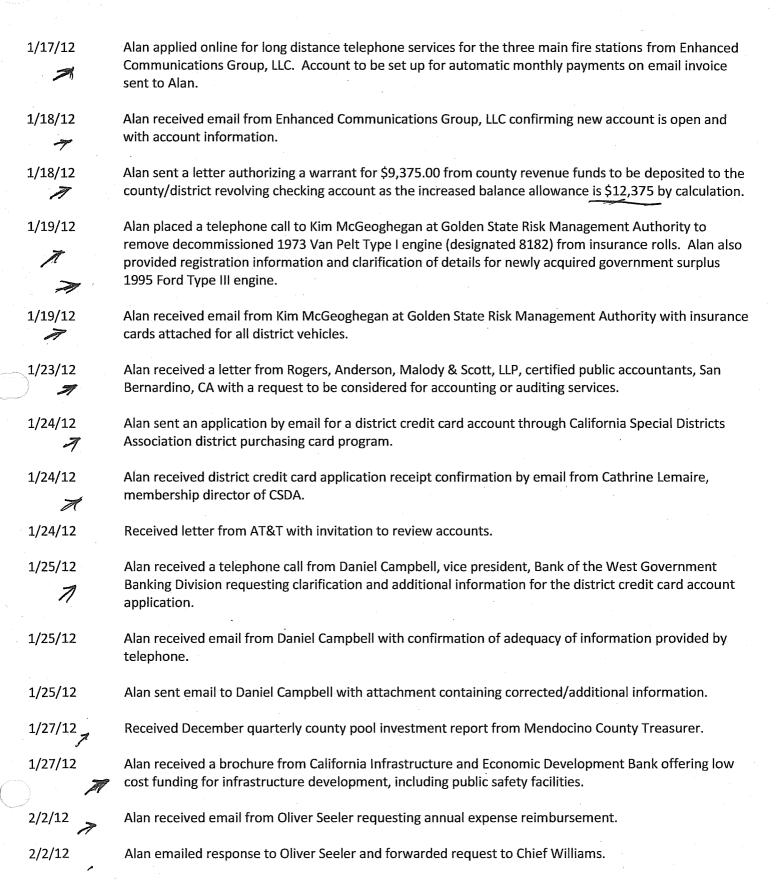

Alan received email from Jennifer Peters of GSRMA with announcement of annual Loss Prevention Incentive Program.

2/6/12 Alan placed telephone call to The Conservation Fund to inquire about lease renewal for Navarro Ridge fire station (815). (Current four year lease expired 12/31/11.) He spoke to Holly, who said she would get information and call back.

2/7/12 Alan received a telephone call from Holly at The Conservation Fund who said that she had a four year renewal contract ready to mail to us. I asked if it would be possible to extend the period of the contract and suggested 20 years as with our lease at the airport. She responded that she would inquire and call back.

2/8/12 Ted passed to Alan a letter addressed to "Albion-Little River Fire" from Carol Millsap Insurance Agency dated November 28, 2011 with a request for detailed fire department information. Ted notes that this is a "board policy issue".

2/9/12 Alan received a letter from Jennifer Peters of GSRMA announcing distribution of and all-in-one labor compliance poster to all members.

2/9/12 Alan received a Navarro Ridge (Station 815) lease renewal document and cover letter from Holly Newberger, office manager of The Conservation Fund.

Alan placed a telephone call to LSN Design, spoke to Todd Neuberger, and asked if there was any news about our fire station project. Todd reported that there was none. I asked if they would try to make some forward progress on the project shop drawings. Todd said he would email Empire Steel and inquire.

Due to the nature of a public funds portfolio, it is mandatory that moneys be available to meet the monetary requirements inherent to operating a public entity. Liquidity needs severely impact investment types; therefore, the pool has substantial funds situated in the Local Agency Investment Fund (LAIF) and the California Asset Management Program (CAMP). Funds in LAIF and CAMP are accessible with same-day notice.

Due to the current financial environment, interest apportionment rates continue to be at historically low rates and will more than likely continue that way until well into 2013. As everyone is aware, financial markets have been difficult on many levels for the past several years; unfortunately, challenges are even greater today given the volatility and uncertainty within the markets.

Program requirements include items such as developing, adopting implementing and maintaining a district personnel policy manual, all board members attending at least one training annually, and having regular safety meetings for all employees. The LPIP was developed in an effort to create behavioral change by member agency's Board and employees towards safety and loss prevention, to improve each member agency's loss prevention and safety programs and to promote greater administrative efficiencies.

Applications for the LPIP are due to Mark Marshall by the first Monday in March each year. This year the applications are due by March 5th. The LPIP application can be found on our website at www.gsrma.org on the Resources Tab under Loss Prevention. An electronic copy has also been attached to this e-mail.

Loss Prevention Incentive Program (LPIP) - 2011/12

Mission Statement: Golden State Risk Management Authority has adopted this program in an effort to create a behavioral change by each member agency's Board and employees towards safety and loss prevention, to improve each member agency's loss prevention and safety programs and to promote greater administrative efficiencies.

GSRMA member agencies can receive an award of up to 10% of the current year's contribution, subject to a \$50,000 maximum* per member agency, per year. Members must re-apply each year to qualify.

To apply, members must complete the attached Self-Evaluation/Application. The completed application shall be reviewed, evaluated, and approved by GSRMA's Safety Officer. 2011-12 LPIP applications must be submitted to GSRMA by March 5th, 2012.

The Safety Officer shall present all qualified evaluations to GSRMA Board of Directors no later than their May board meeting for approval. Awards will be available for distribution prior to July 1st of the current coverage year. To receive distributions, the agency must be a member as of July 1 of the upcoming coverage year.

The credit is based on a points system. 100 points are needed to be awarded the maximum credit. The following formula shall be used in determining the total credit awarded. (**NOTE**: Member agency must score a minimum of 50 points to qualify for an award)

50 Points	2% Credit*
80 Points	5% Credit*
90 Points	7% Credit*
100 Points	10 % Credit*

GSRMA encourages members to use the awarded funds to maintain and/or enhance their loss prevention efforts. Members may choose to receive the funds via check or as a reduction on the next year's contribution. Please designate your disbursement choice at the end of the application.

*Award is subject to the percentage of maximum allowable credit. In order to receive maximum credit, member must score 100 points.

Special Note: Agencies are encouraged to submit the self-evaluation to the Safety Officer regardless of accumulated points.

Per our telephone conversation this morning please find the attached documents pertaining to changes to fiscal operations of the Albion Little River Fire Protection District as we discussed and as follows:

1. SB 288 changes to California Government Code section 53952 and 53961.

In a telephone conversation we had in October we discussed the requirements to implement the changes to allow a greater amount of the district budget to be kept in the revolving fund. At our regular business meeting on October 25, 2011 the board of directors of ALRFPD passed a resolution (certified copy attached) authorizing deposit of district funds into the revolving fund in an amount not to exceed 110% of 1/12th of the district's adopted budget for the current fiscal year.

You have advised us that for the purposes of calculation we may only include the budget items in "Services and Supplies" categories in our total FY budget (excluding employee expenses and capital expenses) to determine the maximum amount allowed in the revolving fund. Per our revised approved FY 2011-2012 budget (certified copy attached) approved at our December 8, 2011 regular business meeting the maximum amount allowed in the revolving fund would be 110% of $1/12^{th}$ of \$135,000 = \$12,375. Currently we have an allowance for a maximum amount of \$3,000 to be held in the revolving fund. If the attached documentation is adequate we will provide a letter of request for a warrant for the difference (\$12,375 - \$3,000 = \$9,375) to deposit into the district revolving fund checking account.

2. Signature requirements for district accounts.

At our regular business meeting on November 29, 2011 the board of directors adopted revised bylaws (certified copy attached, certified approved minutes attached) which, among other changes, reduces the number of signatures required to authorize checks, warrants, and vouchers from two to one. Each of the members of the board of directors and the bookkeeper are authorized signers for each district account. Please note the changes and be advised that from now on vouchers will have a single signature.

Please let me know if you have any questions or if there are any issues with these changes. I would appreciate a timely response so that we may implement these changes as soon as possible. Our next regular business meeting is scheduled for January 12, 2012.

It seems that we are to continue to hear from Mr. Seeler. I have attached some of his latest correspondence and a couple of responses from Chief Ted Williams.

I am writing you to ask your advice on Mr. Seeler's latest request (?!) for "reimbursement checks" for himself and the two other firefighters who resigned from Albion Little River Volunteer Fire Department, Inc. in October (outlook file RE: Further:...).

Current district policy for annual partial compensation of firefighters' expenses (see attached) was established before fire department reorganization and provides for reimbursement to Albion Little River Volunteer Fire Department, Inc. for their annual compensation payments to individual firefighters in December of each year. In the years since this policy was introduced Albion Little River Volunteer Fire Department, Inc. has determined who is eligible for compensation and has made payments to members without any communication or consultation with the district board. The board has then authorized reimbursement to the fire department for their total expenses for this compensation. I have been informed by Chief Williams, who has been a fire department member since the policy was instituted, that Albion Little River Volunteer Fire Department, Inc. has never paid compensation to any member who left the department during the course of the year. Payments were made only to current active members.

December, 2011 was the first month of the district-operated fire department per bylaws adopted at the end of November. Every firefighter who was a current active member of Albion Little River Volunteer Fire Department, Inc. at that time filled out application and employment forms for employment as a volunteer firefighter with Albion Little River Fire Protection District. All (including one of the persons censured in the incident precipitating the resignations of the three now requesting compensation) were hired by recommendation of the chief and a vote of the board of directors.

The district board wished to provide the compensation called for by the policy to these active firefighters giving continuing service to the community through the new organization. As the firefighters are now direct district employees we were able to issue checks in December to individual firefighters. We gave no consideration for compensation to those who left the department prior to the transition.

Now we have this "request" from Mr. Seeler. Obviously we need to update and clarify our policy, but what is our obligation here? There is no written policy in Albion Little River Volunteer Fire Department, Inc. regarding this compensation. There are no employee or compensation references in the previous district bylaws other than the referenced policy. It could be argued that the previous criteria for eligibility for compensation were determined by Mr. Seeler. The last line of the district's current policy seems to corroborate the notion that compensation will only be made to active duty members, but the statement is pretty ambiguous.

The board will be discussing and possibly deciding this issue at the district's regular business meeting Thursday February 9, 2012. We would appreciate any insight/input you can offer.

Appeal

Property owners within the Albion Little River Fire Protection District may request review of the special fire and rescue property tax assessment of their property by submitting a written letter to the Board of Directors of the Albion Little River Fire Protection District or completing the attached form with the following information:

Name of property owner
Date of appeal
Parcel number
Address of the parcel
Mailing address of property owner and phone number
Description of the nature of the appeal

In addition to the above, the applicant should attach copies of relevant documents such as tax bills. The applicant must also include his/her own name, address and phone number.

All appeals will be public information.

Appeal Review Process

A committee of the Board of Directors (2 members) will review the appeal and all documents.

At a regularly scheduled or special Board meeting, each appeal will be considered and a decision made after consideration of the recommendations of the special fire and rescue tax appeal committee.

Every person who has an appeal before the Board will be notified of the date, time, and location of the meeting and is encouraged to attend.

The secretary of the Board will provide the applicant with written notification of the decision.

This policy supersedes Albion Little River Fire Protection District Resolution 2002-02.

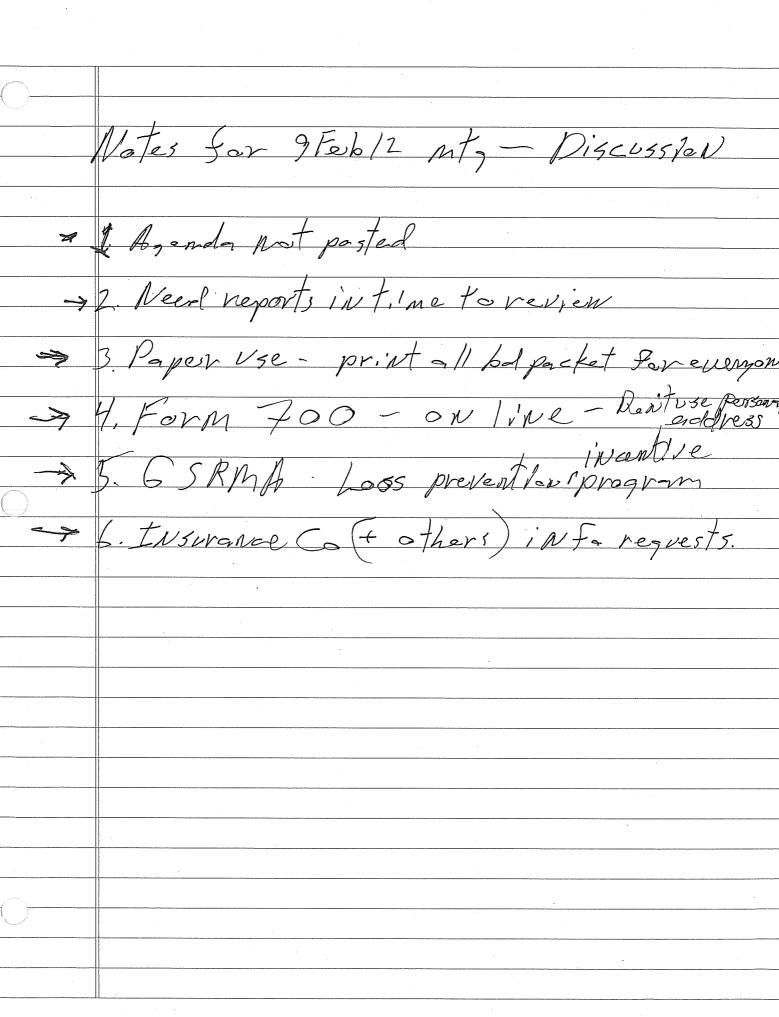

o The Little River Concert Series performance on February 8 was to benefit Albion-Little River Volunteer Fire Department, Inc. Ted Williams attended and spoke with guests at the intermission. Proceeds have not been calculated by ALRVFD, Inc.

Development:

- o Focus remains on legal compliance, training the basics to new firefighters, personal protective equipment standardization and issue, cleaning and maintenance.
- o Ted continued to research CAFS and believe we should pursue a starter system.
- Ted met CHP at station 811 for a VIN verification of engine 8170 (USDA FS) and completed registration with the DMV. 8170 now has plates.
- On January 14, Marshall and Andrea restocked rescue 8130 with 2 BVM, 2 infant BVM, 2 manual suction, tourniquet, sterile supplies, bandaids, chest seals, abdominal pads, 3 rolls of sam splints, gloves, snap straps (replacing sticky straps), and head blocks (now only one type).
- On January 14, Marshall, Erica and Andrea washed 8170 and 8162.
- The flats has offered to store a container for our boat/water equipment. Close proximity and easy access will
 provide much shorter response times.
- Driver/Operator 1A written exam results are not yet available from the Sacramento.
- We will investigate a district operated BLS ambulance as part of our long range plan.

Station Maintenance

 We held a work party on January 28. Stations 810 and 811 were cleaned. We disposed of over five cubic yards of trash and deprecated equipment. We plan to address station 812 next.

- Mendocino Coast Water Works completed plumbing replacement of old waste and gas lines. The gas pipes passed a test provided by our propane vendor.
- Ted researched the history of West Street, the entrance road to station 810. The county Department of Transportation now agrees that the street is a county right of way, but was not able to locate a record of the street being maintained. Norman De Vall was able to recall county improvements to the road during his term as supervisor. Dan Hamburg, current 5th district supervisor, has offered to make the case for county maintenance in March when supervisors vote on the "maintained mileage list". According to Hamburg, Howard Dashiell, director of MCDoT, will recommend adding West Street Albion-0.2 miles (100 feet) to the list. If successful, this will put the county road crew on track to rock in April or May. A concern raised which could negatively impact the project is continued use of the area by adjacent property owners as a private driveway and parking area.
