Board discussed whether this purchase was still the best for coverage of the District. At this time the Board has allocated \$100,000 for the purchase. The type 3 available for purchase needs \$35,000 more. Dan made a motion to increase the equipment budget from \$110,000 to \$145,000 with \$135,000 allocated towards the total cost of this vehicle. Motion was unanimously carried.
